- 3) Main purpose may not be for a Political Reason
- 4) Thus: Long Term Protection of the Capel Green Belt
- 5) Major Focus on SaveCapel (Ring Fenced donations)

- 2) Constitution (16.06.19)
- 3) Registration submitted to Charity Commission: Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) 3 month wait...
- 4) HSBC Community Account Banking for Campaign Funds (19 August 2019)
